POSITION SUMMARY:

Camp Erin Montgomery County is a weekend, overnight camp (one weekend each year) for children and teens ages 6-17 who are grieving the death of a significant person in their lives. The program combines traditional, fun camp activities with grief education and emotional support, free of charge for all families. Led by grief professionals and trained volunteers, Camp Erin provides a unique opportunity for youth to increase levels of hope, enhance self-esteem, and especially to learn that they are not alone. **Next Camp Erin dates are May 2-4, 2025**.

In collaboration with the Camp Erin Director, the clinical director will be responsible for the following tasks:

- Schedule, coordinate and conduct family/camper intakes
- Plan bereavement activities during camp, in compliance with established guidelines
- Define goals and debrief questions for bereavement activities
- Assist struggling campers during Camp Erin Session
- Interview, orient and support Camp Erin facilitators
- Plan and implement volunteer training
- Develop schedule for the weekend
- Assist with bunk assignments, big buddy to camper assignments, and facilitation group assignments

- Take inventory of bereavement activity supplies and order supplies as necessary
- Assist with the planning and implementation of Family Kickoff and Post-Camp reunion
- Train and support volunteers in addressing bereavement-related issues

MISCELLANEOUS:

- Attend agency-wide activities such as staff retreats and celebrations
- Attend and work at CM fundraising events as available
- Other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's Degree or higher in counseling, social work or related field preferred
- Experience working closely with children and/or teens as well as adult family members
- Ability to develop warm and nurturing bonds with children at camp
- Ability to provide support to big buddies and facilitators in supporting campers
- Ability to work effectively with people from diverse backgrounds
- Bilingual (Spanish) strongly desired
